Online Classes

Academics

In this pandemic situation too we give prime importance to academics of Chavarites through the dedicated service of staff. Online classes have been conducted with great seriousness, and the participation of students are been monitored frequently. Thus maximum number of students attend the classes regularly. As a result students are updated academically as they have regular classes.

- From November two monthly tests and two periodic tests have been conducted for all students. Two parents meetings were conducted during PT-1 and PT -2 on Result publishing days.

- Regular classes for 9th and 10th students started from February 1st with the consent of all parents, strictly following the Covid – 19 protocol. We conduct classes for 9th and 10th students on alternative days.

- Since the portions are completed , revisions for all subjects are given to all classes.

Christmas Celebration

Students miss all the cultural activities during corona time. But our students got a chance to perform their cultural talents on the occasion of Christmas. One hour Christmas programme has been staged on 22nd December and telecasted live through our YouTube Channel. More than 1000 people watched the programme in YouTube live. Principal, during his Christmas message, reminded that we have to be good to others by being at their service in their needs.

Republic Day Celebration

Republic Day was celebrated on 26th January 2021. Rev.Fr.Jins V Thomas, the manager, hoisted the flag and gave the message of the day. He insisted that we should be aware that the effort made by the freedom fighters and the leaders who made the constitution and how it is misinterpreted and forced on citizens. He pointed out that the situation arises even farmers are struggling to get minimum value for their crops, but govt manipulate their plea and budging them as anti nationalists. Multiple cultural programmes which are related to patriotism were performed, Prizes of Gandhi Jayanthi completions were distributed during the occasion.
